## Tobacco products package coverage and location

Graphic health warnings are required to cover the top 50% of the front and 50% of the back of the package. Overall, 50% of the package space is allocated to health warnings.

### Misleading information

Misleading descriptors such as 'light,' 'ultra light,' 'mild,' etc., figures for emission yields (including tar, nicotine, and carbon monoxide) and expiration dates are prohibited from appearing on packages.

### Constituents and emissions information

No message is required to display qualitative (descriptive) constituents and emissions information.

#### Special notes

Legislation applies to all tobacco products (combusted and smokeless) without specifying the content of the warnings for each type of tobacco.

# Rotation schedule, history, language, and help for smoking cessation

Suriname has produced one round of graphic health warning labels:

Round (Year)	Number	Size (%) [average— front/back]
R1 (2014)	6 pairs	50 — 50/50

Warnings within the round are required to be rotated for a period of 18 months. Warning texts are in English; however, the principal language of the country is Dutch. No quitline phone number or government-sponsored website is required to be displayed on the package.
